The departments strive for effective curriculum delivery through a combination of time-tested and innovative methods: beginning with an entry-point assessment of the student's aptitude and expectations relating to the course; and proceeding according to a set of teaching plans based on an academic calendar detailed enough to cover the available timeframe, yet flexible enough to permit changes. Subject-wise teaching plans are prepared by all the teachers & reviewed monthly by the Head of Department. The department planner and academic calendar helps to ensure that the schedule is followed. The Academic calendar & course syllabus is available on the college website & is accessible to all the students at the beginning of the semester. Faculty members take utmost care to complete the syllabus in time. Tutorials/projects, class tests and internal assessments comprise the formal evaluative processes, but students are encouraged to meet faculty beyond classroom hours for doubt-clearing and curricular discussions. Teachers use various learning methodologies like flipped classroom, experiential learning, and case study to help students understand the concepts better.
