Agenda I-Confirmation of the minutes of meeting held on 18th May 2020.

Mrs. Vinaya Vaishampayan read out the minutes of the last meeting and they were confirmed.

Agenda II- To examine the awareness measures and to sensitize students to zero tolerance policy against Ragging in the institution-

It was suggested in the last meeting that the students take up a project whereby a short video and street plays regarding ill effects of ragging and punishments for offenders would be highlighted.

2 short videos were created and played during the meeting. All the committee members approved of the videos and it was decided that the videos will be displayed on college Website.

It was reported that no cases of ragging have been reported.
