**ADMISSION PROCEDURE 2021-2022**

Following are the proposed steps that the department will be following for the admission procedure of first year students for the MSc CNL course.

1. Students have to fill the online registration forms (**A, B, C & D form**) not later than 15th July, 2021, by 5.00 pm (IST) (subjected to changes). The list of mandatory forms is as follows:

**a. A form: -SNDT – BMN college portal admission form**

(www.sndtdigitaluniveristy.ac.in)

**b. B Form :- BMN college portal admission form** (Autonomous form- available on BMN website- www.bmncollege.com)

c. An Online form for uploading marksheets and other details to be filled after completing the above 2 forms mentioned. Students failing to fill the **A & B form** will be disqualified for the entrance examination

d. **C form:** An online consent form for provisional admission (google form will be circulated via email)

e. **D form:** An online form to be filled after the payment of entrance fees. (google form will be circulated via email)

2. List of candidates who have completed the registration and payment process (filled all the 4- **A, B, C & D forms**) will be compiled and sent to the MKCL by 16th July, 2021
3. The applicants will be shortlisted on the basis of the eligibility criteria (uploaded on BMN website- www.bmncollege.com). The shortlisting will be carried out by MKCL on the basis of eligibility criteria provided on BMN website.
4. The eligible students will be intimated regarding the common entrance test details by MKCL through emails only.
5. The exam through online mode will be conducted by MKCL for which a mock test will be held by MKCL before 2-3 days of final exam which will be intimated to all the students via email.
6. The eligible students seeking **PROVISIONAL admission** for the course will be shortlisted on the basis of merit by MKCL. (Annexure 1)

7. The first list of selected students (MSc CND - 40 students) will be displayed on the college website within **3 working days** after completion of the exam. (21st July, 2021- after 6.00pm) on college website only.
8. These students must pay the required course fee (details will be mentioned on the college website) within **3to 4 working days** after display of the list (21st-22nd July, 2021). **Mode of payment: Online only**
9. The second list, for the remaining seats (seats not filled from the first list), will be updated on **26th July, 2021-6.00pm** on the college website only.
10. These students must pay the course fee within **3to 4 working days** of display of the list (**by 29th - 30th July, 2021**).
11. Third list, if required, will follow a similar process.
12. NOTE: If students have applied for both courses (MSc CND & PGDSSFN), admission will be given as per student's first preference. (preference to be indicated in the provisional registration form- **form C**)
13. After completion of the admission process students will be informed by the department for orientation and commencement of lectures through email.
14. **NOTE:** The admission given to the students **will be provisional only**. The college can cancel the admission if the selected student fails to receive the graduation degree (in case of ATKT). Refund of fees will be as per the SNTD rule (mentioned on the college website)

#### **ANNEXURE 1: Merit list for provisional admission**

1. Aggregate marks for 5 semesters (Semester I-V) will be considered based on the marksheets provided by the applicant.
2. The aggregate marks should be minimum 50% (or B grade) for applicants belonging to the nutritional background (B.Sc. Foods and Nutrition, B.Sc. Food Science and Nutrition, B.Sc. Clinical Nutrition and Dietetics/Nutrition and Dietetics, B.Sc. Public Health and Nutrition, B.Sc. Applied Nutrition.).
3. The aggregate marks should be minimum 55% (or B grade) for applicants belonging to pure science background (B.Sc. Life Sciences, B.Sc. Biochemistry, B.Sc. Biotechnology, B.Sc. Physiology, B.Sc. Zoology, B.Sc. Molecular Biology, B.Sc. Clinical and Laboratory Sciences). Applicants belonging to this category should have completed a total 32 credits under the semester pattern or 600 marks under the annual pattern in the following subjects:
  - a) Chemistry
  - b) Biology
  - c) Physiology
4. The aggregate marks should be minimum 50% or B grade for students with Postgraduate Diplomas in Dietetics, Applied Nutrition, Sports Sciences Fitness and Nutrition, Public Health, Clinical Research.
5. **NOTE:** applicants belonging to any category must not have any ATKT in any semester, if any ATKT was there, it should be cleared before appearing for the entrance exam.
