




Bhagat Singh was an Indian socialist revolutionary, and one of the pivotal heroes of India's Independence Movement. He is popularly known as 'Shaheed e Azam' Bhagat Singh.

Bhagat Singh attended Dayanad Anglo Vedic High School and then National College, both located in Lahore. He started to fight for India's Independence at a young a very age. He was a writer and an editor for Punjabi-Urdu newspaper. He popularized the slogan 'Inquilab Zindabad' meaning 'Long Live the Revolution' which was coined by Urdu Poet Maulana Hasrat Mohani. To avenge the death of Indian Leader Lala Lajpat Rai, Singh and others plotted to kill the Police responsible for it, but it a case of mistaken identity, an officer called J. P Saunders was killed 1928. To protest the implementation of Defense of India Act, Singh and an associate lobbed a bomb at the Central Legislative Assembly. He surrendered later and was hanged at the age of 23.
