NOTICE FOR ONLINE NUTRITION & DIETETICS SELECTION TEST

First year BSc Students (academic year-2021-22) who have applied for the Nutrition and Dietetics specialization are hereby informed that the selection test for admission which will be conducted on **15th SEPTEMBER 2021**.

SELECTION TEST DAY & DATE: WEDNESDAY, 15th SEPTEMBER 2021.

TIME- 9.00 – 9:20 a.m.

Selection Test will be conducted in truly **Online Mode** from any location suitable for the student.

MOCK TEST:

There will be no MOCK Test conducted by the college for the above Selection Test.

Process Of Application to B.Sc. in Nutrition and Dietetics (ND)- 2021-22 (Self-Financed Program)

1. Students must register and first take admission in the Basic BSc course.
2. They may choose to apply to Nutrition and Dietetics Specialization if they so desire.
3. Eligibility Criteria:

Students interested in applying for Nutrition and Dietetics must –

- ❖ Have passed HSC board examination or Equivalent Board exam.
- ❖ Only those students who have studied Pure Science or Science with Home Science are eligible to apply.

❖ To be eligible to appear for the selection test student must have more than 65% aggregate in the HSC

4. Scores will be formulated after the selection test. (Details for Selection test and formulation of the scores are given below.)

5. Seats will be allotted purely on the basis of the Merit score. Any attempt to use external/unfair means to secure a seat will lead to automatic disqualification of the student.

❖ Paper Details-

- A 30-mark MCQ test will be conducted. 30 questions will have to be answered in 20 minutes. Each question will be for 1 mark. Students have to attempt all 30 questions
- Questions will be testing the competency level of the student in Physiology and Health, Applied Chemistry and Nutrition.
- Basic knowledge regarding all these subjects is expected to from the study of science subjects from standard 8 to Standard 12. General aspects related to diet, health and disease are expected to be known, as the candidate is interested in studying and specializing in the field of dietetics.

Final Scores-Final scores will be formulated by taking the aggregate percentage of the HSC exam and adding to the score of the selection test for each candidate. Total scores therefore will be out of 130.

Allocation of Seats and Payment of fees-

- Seats will be allotted to the specialization of Nutrition and Dietetics solely based on merit list drawn up from the total score.
- Students must secure their seat by paying balance fees within 3 days of declaration of the Merit List. Failing to do so, the seat will be awarded to the next candidate on the Merit List.

GUIDELINES / INSTRUCTIONS / RULES FOR APPEARING FOR THE ONLINE SELECTION TEST

1. Students should attend the Online Selection Test using Following Pattern.
[First Name] space [Last Name] space [BMN application number]
For example:
Aarti Shah 5008
2. Students can give the Test with one of the options given below:
 - i. A Desktop Computer with working Camera and Internet Connectivity
 - ii. A Laptop with Camera and Internet Connectivity
 - iii. Two Mobiles (Smart Phone) with working cameras and Internet Connectivity (First Mobile for Zoom Meet where Supervisor will see the activity of the student and Second Mobile for answering the MCQ Paper using the Google Form link).
3. Use of a Web Camera/Mobile Camera is mandatory in order to attempt all Online Test. Web Cameras should be connected to the PC/Laptop on which the Test is being attempted and it should be always in ON state and Mic on Mute Mode. Students MUST ensure that the Camera of Mobile phone is working.
4. Candidate should position herself in front of the Webcam/Mobile Camera appropriately with her face being clearly visible & she should ensure that the Webcam/Mobile Camera is properly recording her throughout the Test.
5. Please ensure that the face and ears are clearly visible in the Webcam/Mobile Camera Preview window.
6. Ensure that the surrounding area is well illuminated for clear visibility.
7. If the Webcam/Mobile Camera is disconnected from the PC/Laptop/Mobile any time during the test, then the Teacher Supervisor for the Test will eliminate the student from the ZOOM Meet Platform immediately after the second warning to the student.
8. The candidate must ensure that during the Test no other person gets captured in the Web/Mobile Camera Preview. Candidates may get disqualified if any such activity is recorded.

9. The following activities are strictly prohibited during the Test:

- Use of Electronic Devices, Stationery items like Text Material (Pen Drives, Electronic Pen/Scanner etc.).
- Use of Tele-communication devices like Headphones, Bluetooth Earphones, Pager, Health Band etc.

10. It is the student's sole responsibility to be properly dressed during the Online Test and be mindful of the fact that a Video Recording is being done. The candidate should ensure a proper posture and place the camera correctly so that there is no indecent exposure.

11. Wear decent clothing during the Test.

12. The actions performed by the candidate on the Test Window Interface will be recorded throughout the Test duration. Also, the candidate's continuous live recording shall happen while attempting the Test.

13. This recorded information will be used only for the purpose of ensuring fairness and transparency while conducting the Test & also solely used for the purpose of monitoring the Test.

14. Make sure that there is no noise in the background during the Test.

15. While attempting the Selection Test, no other application or Web page should be opened other than the ZOOM Meet and Google Link Form provided by the Teacher, except for students using Mobiles for transferring the Google Form Multiple Choice Question Paper Link to their second Mobile. Switching, minimizing or closing the Selection Test Window is not allowed during the Test.

16. If the Candidate closes the Test Window without submitting the form her result will not be considered for further process.

17. Candidate needs to complete the Test within the mentioned time only. Extension of time beyond the stipulated time is not allowed.

18. No extra time will be provided if students face problems with the Network, Technical issues etc.

19. It is advisable to keep one alternate resource in case of an emergency.

20. Availability of the Hardware, Software, Broadband, Internet & Power backup at the time of the Test is the sole responsibility of the candidate and College will not be responsible for any delay in the TEST due to the failure of the above-mentioned resources on the part of the candidate. No time extension shall be given in any case and no such calls will be entertained. Hence, candidates should ensure and plan accordingly about the availability of the proper backup and alternate resources. The expenses incurred for making the above setup ready for the Test shall be borne by the candidates themselves.

21. If due to any reason, the computer shuts down or the Entrance Test Window closes, the candidate needs to notify Dr. Harsha Chopra on +91-9969810104 and can again start ZOOM Meet and Google form and can continue with the Test from the beginning. For instance, if the candidate has started giving the Test at 09:00 a.m. and at 09:10 a.m. she has a problem and

experiences a hung system, then the candidate needs to immediately inform on the above-mentioned mobile number and can again restart ZOOM Meet and Google Form and can continue with the Test from the beginning. But the above option will work only till the end of the Test time as mentioned in the schedule. i.e., the balance duration of the Test i.e. till 9:20 am only.

22. The College has the sole discretion to disqualify the candidate if the candidate fails to follow the pre-test instructions or causes a breach in the terms and conditions of Online Test or has submitted false or incorrect or incomplete information, or for any other reason the Selection Cell finds appropriate.

23. There is No Negative Marking.

24. The College reserves all rights to change any above-mentioned Rules and Regulations at any stage during the entire process.

TIPS FOR STUDENTS

- Be ready half an hour before the Test.
- If student is using the Mobile for the Test, then the Mobile must be Charged, updated and unnecessary data removed.
